The Khans Supa IGA Supermarket Group has 10 stores across NSW, including Bourke, Cobar, Coonamble, Nyngan and Lightning Ridge.

Managing Director, Rashid Khan, will present the cheque to Ms Cutler today at the RFDS Dubbo Base.

"The donation comes from our Community Chest program, which supports organisations the board deems to be "doing good" in the community," said Mr Khan.

"I opened my first store in Lightning Ridge in 1981 and understand what an important lifeline the RFDS is for people in Central Western NSW."
