

Primary Health Care Service

The RFDS Primary Health Care Service is available to all residents living, working and travelling in remote South Australia, including districts of the Flinders Ranges, Gawler Ranges, Birdsville Track and Far North, and the communities of Yalata and Oak Valley.

Service

Integrated health services are delivered by a combination of telephone consultations, a calendar of scheduled 'fly-in' GP/Nurse/Midwife clinics and in-situ Remote Area Nurse (RAN) clinics at Andamooka, Marla and Marree.

Remote RFDS patients (and RFDS Medical Chest holders) visiting Port Augusta can arrange a consultation at the RFDS Port Augusta Base by prior appointment.

Clinicians

The RFDS Primary Health Care Service is delivered by a team of General Practitioners, GP Registrars, Registered Nurses and Midwives.

The Service is supported by a Practice Manager, administration staff and 24/7 Operations Control Centre, all located at the RFDS Port Augusta Base.

HEALTH SERVICES

Operating from the RFDS Port Augusta Base, the RFDS Primary Health Care Service offers remote patients a complete primary health care service:

Telephone Consultations

Telephone consultations with a RFDS Doctor are available by calling 1800 RFDS SA (1800 733 772).

If the on-call RFDS Doctor is busy with another patient or on an emergency evacuation, you will receive a call back from a doctor as soon as possible.

Appointments

Appointments for the regular fly-in clinics must be made by 12-noon on the day before the scheduled fly-in clinic.

Please advise at the time of booking an appointment if a procedure is required e.g. immunisation, pap smear or minor surgery.

Longer consultation times are available. Please advise at the time of booking your appointment if you require extra time.

A copy of the fly-in clinic calendar can be obtained by calling the RFDS Port Augusta Base.

If you require urgent medical assistance, call 1800 RFDS SA (1800 733 772) and ask to speak to the on-call RFDS Doctor.

Reminder System

Our practice is committed to preventative health care. You can register to receive reminder notices for health services specific to your care.

Walk-in Appointments

Patients requesting walk-in appointments at scheduled fly-in clinic locations will be allocated the first available consultation, however they may be required to wait for the next scheduled clinic.

Station Visits

Station visits can be requested by contacting the RFDS Practice Manager and may be scheduled according to the RFDS calendar of regular fly-in clinics.

Doctor/Nurse consultations may take place inside the RFDS aircraft or in the homestead depending on the number of patients and the requirements of their consultation.

For consultations in the homestead, families are required to provide the following:

- > Transport for the RFDS crew and their equipment from the airstrip to the homestead;
- > A room with a door that can be closed, a small desk, three chairs and a bed; and
- > Access to clean, running water and a toilet.

Fees and Billing Arrangements

No fees are payable by patients for the RFDS Primary Health Care Service. Medicare rebates do not apply. Your Medicare number is required for prescriptions, pathology, radiology, and some specialist referrals.

Test Results

At the time of ordering any test the Doctor/Nurse will arrange with you to follow up the results.

For results that require urgent follow up, the Doctor/Nurse will contact you directly by telephone or through a Remote Area Nurse.

If you have concerns about results, you can contact the RFDS Port Augusta Base during office hours and request a telephone consultation with the Doctor.
