Life Saving Work

As well as providing emergency healthcare we facilitate over 15,000 clinics across Australia every year. By addressing health concerns early, the need for an emergency retrieval later can often be avoided.

In addition to doctors and pilots, our team includes mental health nurses, dentists and specialists. We take health services to remote communities so people living, working or travelling in Outback Australia can access care when they need it.
